DAILY PRAYER TO OUR HEAVENLY FATHER

(St. Louis Marie de Montfort)

I, (your name), a faithless sinner, renew and ratify today in thy hands, O Immaculate Mother, the vows of my Baptism; I renounce forever satan, his pomps and works; and I give myself entirely to Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Wisdom, to carry my cross after Him all the days of my life, and to be more faithful to Him than I have ever been before.

In the presence of all the heavenly court I choose thee this day for my Mother and Queen. I deliver and consecrate to thee, as thy slave, my body and soul; my goods, both interior and exterior; and even the value of all my good actions, past, present and future, leaving to thee the entire and full right of disposing of me and all that belongs to me without exception, according to thy good pleasure, for the greater glory of God in time and in eternity.

ACT OF CONTRITION

O my Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, behold me kneeling before Thy Divine Presence, all in confusion at the thought of the many grievous injuries I have done Thee. Now I ask pardon for them, repenting of them, purely for love of Thee and ready to lose my life rather than offend Thee again. Do Thou, most tender Virgin, Mother of Mercy and Refuge of Sinners, obtain for me the pardon of all my sins by virtue of thy bitter pains. Help me so to pray as, to gain all the graces attached to this, your Holy Rosary. Amen.

PRAYER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful, kindle in them the Fire of Thy Love. Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created. And Thou shall renew the face of the earth. DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

(Saint Maria Faustina)

Sign of the Cross

(Opening Prayer) You expired Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You! (three times)

Our Father, Hail Mary, Apostles Creed

(On the Our Father Beads)

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(On the Hail Mary Beads)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Three times at the end)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Closing Prayer) Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is love and mercy itself.
Amen.

DEVOTION TO THE SEVEN SORROWS OF MARY

The Blessed Virgin Mary grants seven graces to the souls who honor her daily by mediating on her tears and dolors (sorrows). This devotion was passed on by St. Bridget of Sweden.

1. I will grant peace to their families.
2. They will be enlightened by the divine mysteries.
3. I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work.
4. I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my divine Son or the sanctification of their souls.
5. I will defend them in the spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant in their lives.
6. I will visibly help them at the moment of their death, they will see the face of their Mother.
7. I have obtained (This Grace) from my divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolors, will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness since all their sins will be forgiven and my Son and I will be their eternal consolation and joy.

Promises for Praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy given to St. Faustina

"Oh, what great graces I will grant to souls who say this Chaplet. Write down these words, my daughter. Speak to the world about My mercy; let all mankind recognize my unfathomable mercy. It is a sign for the end times; after it will come the day of justice. While there is still time, let them have recourse to the fount of my mercy; let them profit from the blood and water which gushed forth for them" (Diary, 848).

"Say unceasingly the Chaplet that I have taught you. Whoever will recite it, they will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire that the whole world know My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy." (diary, 687).

The Promise of the Grace of Mercy for The Dying given to St. Faustina

"It pleases me to grant everything souls ask of me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one. Write this for the benefit of distressed souls; when a soul sees and realizes the gravity of its sins, when the whole abyss of the misery into which it immersed itself is displayed before its eyes, let it not despair, but with trust let it throw itself into the arms of My mercy, as a child into the arms of its beloved mother. Tell them no soul that has called upon My mercy has been disappointed or brought to shame. I delight particularly in a soul that has placed its trust in My goodness. Write that when they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful Savior" (Diary, 1541).

Fifteen Promises of Mary to Christians who recite the Rosary Given to St. Dominic and Blessed Alan de la Roche

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary shall receive signal graces.
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against Hell; it will destroy vice, decrease sin and defeat heresies.
4. It will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means!
5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.
6. Whoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its sacred Mysteries, shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice; he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just, he shall remain in the grace of God and become worthy of eternal life.
7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.
8. Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have during their life and at their death the light of God and the plentitude of His graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the Saints in Paradise.
9. I shall deliver from Purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.
10. The faithful children of the Rosary shall merit a high degree of glory in Heaven.
11. You shall obtain all you ask of me by the recitation of the Rosary.
12. All those who propagate the Holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.
13. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire celestial court during their life and at the hour of death.
14. All who recite the Rosary are my sons, and brothers of my only Son, Jesus Christ.
15. Devotion to my Rosary is a great sign of predestination.

The Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary

(How to pray the Most Holy Rosary)

- While holding the Crucifix, make the Sign of the Cross and then recite the Apostles' Creed.
- Recite the Our Father on the first large bead.
- Recite a Hail Mary on each of the three small beads for an increase of faith, hope and charity.
- Recite the Glory Be.
- Recall the first Rosary Mystery and recite the Our Father on the next large bead.
- Recite a Hail Mary on each of the adjacent ten small beads while reflecting on the Mystery.
- Recite the Glory Be.
- Each succeeding decade is prayed in a similar manner by recalling the appropriate Mystery, reciting the Our Father, ten Hail Mary's and the Glory Be, while reflecting on the Mystery.
- When the fifth Mystery is completed, the Rosary is customarily concluded with the Hail, Holy Queen.

The Five Joyful Mysteries

The Annunciation, The Visitation, The Birth of Jesus,
The Presentation, The Finding of Jesus in the Temple.

The Five Luminous Mysteries

The Baptism of Jesus, The Wedding Feast at Cana,
The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, The
Transfiguration, The Institution of the Holy Eucharist.

The Five Sorrowful Mysteries

The Agony in the Garden, The Scourging at the Pillar,
The Crowning with Thorns, The Carrying of the Cross,
The Crucifixion

The Five Glorious Mysteries

The Resurrection, The Ascension, The Descent of the
Holy Spirit, The Assumption, The Coronation.

GLORY BE

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen

APOSTLES CREED

THE RITE OF COVENANT FOR THE DIRECTIVES FROM HEAVEN BY MARY THE MOTHER OF GOD

The Rite of Covenant is normally administered to aspirants only subsequent to their attending at least six Daughters of the Lamb regular, monthly meetings – in order to provide both the aspirants and the community sufficient opportunity to reasonably discern their mutual compatibility with one another, and whether the aspirants have a true vocation, sustained interest, dedication, and faithfulness.

(NORMALLY ADMINISTERED AT THE END OF A MONTHLY MEETING)

LEADER: *Oh Most Blessed Trinity please come to us through the heart of Thy Mother Mary where all is and all will be now and forever.* THE DAUGHTERS OF THE LAMB of the IMMACULATE CONCEPTION will be established solely for the purpose of saving souls, no other reason – REDEMPTION – bringing souls to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit thru Me your Mother.

LEADER: “Oh Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.”

COMMUNITY: “Amen.”

LEADER: As the psalmist says (Ps 44:11-12), “Hearken, O daughter, and see, and incline thy ear:...; for he is the Lord thy God, and him they shall adore.” A Daughter of the Lamb is a daughter of the Lord, that very Lord of whom John the Baptist spoke (Jn 1:29) when: “The next day he saw Jesus...and said, ‘Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.’”

LEADER: Dear Daughter(s), we gather here together in community to witness your covenant with God, and your signature as an indelible record and testimony of its creation. By this sacred covenant you freely pledge that you will consistently and perpetually strive to faithfully fulfill each of the following Directives from Heaven by the Mother of God:

1. All souls devoted to Me and who wish to propagate or follow this apostolate – will consecrate themselves to Me daily by reciting the Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
2. They will wear My holy scapular that is to be dedicated and consecrated to this apostolate of mercy – a special scapular in honor of My Immaculate Conception and for the salvation of souls.
3. Daily Mass if able – if one cannot then they are to designate a specific day during the week for Mass, in offering for the work of saving souls, for the Daughters of the Lamb.
4. Adoration weekly for one hour to Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and to recite the divine praises.

5. Confession Weekly – keeping oneself in a state of grace.
6. The Holy Rosary to be prayed every day, along with the Seven Sorrows of My Heart and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. These 3 devotions are necessary in keeping oneself protected, devoted to Me and in a state of receiving graces and will help souls obtain Heaven.*
7. Being a good and holy steward to each other and to prepare yourselves to accept all things no matter what the consequences being – loving your neighbor in charity.
8. Being able to do God’s will – total abandonment of oneself to God, so He may direct you.
9. Totally dependent on God and Me your Mother, so we may form you into TRUE children of God.

You are now invited to sign the copy of this pledge (covenant) which is provided in the appendix of your *Daughters of the Lamb* booklet – this will constitute your own personal record. The fact of your signing it, and the date of signature, will be inscribed in our Community Register next to your name.

Following the SIGNING the Leader addresses the Candidate(s) saying:

“CONGRATULATIONS AND BLESSINGS”

*And then leads the Community in a brief Applause,
and in praying the*

“GLORY BE TO THE FATHER....”
to conclude the ceremony.

* Pray the Seven Dolors Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet daily. Pray the Regular Rosary daily – including at least one of its four parts (i.e., The Five Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful, or Glorious Mysteries).

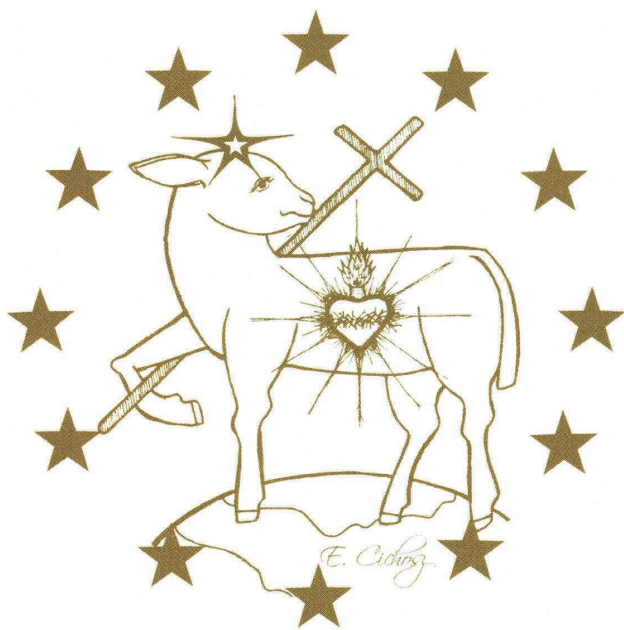
